TATEK ABEBE

Tatek Abebe is a professor of childhood studies at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology, where he teaches postgraduate courses on cultural epistemologies of childhood, children, youth and development, participatory methodologies, and ethics. His longitudinal ethnographic research in Ethiopia examines how young people are affected by and shape the sociocultural and political-economic environments they inhabit with an emphasis on intergenerational relationships, rights, care, work, schooling, education, and activism. He has published scholarly articles and book chapters on these intersecting areas as well as on a wide range of topics concerning precarious childhoods and youth in diverse African settings. His coedited books cover themes on childhood and local knowledge, learning and labouring, children and global development, and decolonial childhood studies.
